



Graduate Assistantships Available 2009-2010

Graduate Assistantships are available for students pursuing a MS or PhD in Technology Education. Assistantships are for 9, 10 or 12 months of work. Non-resident tuition is waived for MS students. All tuition is waived for PhD students.

Annual stipends for these positions are \$12,000 for an MS student, \$15,000 for a 10 month PhD student, or \$18,000 for a 12 month PhD student.

One Position:

Assist with Junior Engineering which is a road show that introduces elementary school students to basic engineering principles. Graduate assistant will be involved in the development of hands-on activities and school demonstrations. Some travel is required.

One Position:

Engineering and technology education research related to biological and/or environmental engineering.

One Position:

Engineering and technology education research related to STEM professional development for teachers of American Indian students.

One Position:

Engineering and technology education research related to high school automation and controls curriculum development.

One Position:

Engineering and technology education research related to cognition in engineering problem solving activities.
